MINISTRY OF HEALTH UPDATED GUIDELINES – LETTER DATED ON 25.10.2021 - ENTERING INTO SRI LANKA - SRI LANKAN SEAFARERS ARRIVING VIA AIRPORTS & SEA PORTS

"Fully vaccinated" travelers - recommended doses of the vaccine completed, depart from origin country after two weeks (14 days) of fully vaccination

"Pre-Departure PCR" -a valid negative PCR report in English, conducted before 72hrs of embarking at the origin / RAT within 48hrs of embarking

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SRI LANKAN SEAFARERS SEAFARERS OR SEA MARSHALS ARRIVING INTO SRI LANKA

Not fully vaccinated Sri Lankan Seafarers or Sea marshals, arriving via seaports / Airports

- Not received COVID 19 Vaccination/ not completed the recommended doses / arriving into Sri Lanka in less than 14 days of recommended doses of vaccination
- Should perform a PCR test in day 1 at Ministry of Health approved laboratory at Katunayake or at a government quarantine center / quarantine hotel / safe and secure level 1 certified hotel / isolation center
- If the day 1 PCR test Is negative, can undergo at Home Quarantine (facilities should be available)
- Should perform exit COVID 19 PCR test / Rapid Antigen Test on 07th day and producing the negative results of PCR/ Antigen tests reports to area MOH

Fully vaccinated Sri Lankan Seafarers or Sea marshals, Arriving via Airports

- Should be fully vaccinated/ 72hrs prior Embarkation conducted negative PCR report / 48hs prior conducted Antigen Report
- For Sri Lankan Seafarers, if the pre-boarding PCR test is exempted, they should undergo day 1 PCR test at the Ministry of Health approved laboratory at Katunayake or at a government quarantine center / quarantine hotel / safe and secure level 1 certified hotel / isolation center. They can be released with a negative PCR port and do not need to undergo quarantine.
- If develop COVID 19 like Symptoms, should conduct a PCR test from a MOH approved lab and produce to area MOH

Fully vaccinated Sri Lankan Seafarers or Sea marshals, Arriving via Seaports

• Should undergo a day 1 PCR and at isolation center (quarantine center for Seafarers / se marshals) and can be released with a negative PCR report, Do not need to undergo for quarantine

Travelers with Positive COVID 19 Test

- OIC of IC / Hotel Doctor /Hotel Management / Local agent should inform to MOH/email the details to epidemiology
 unit
- All the approved labs should inform to Epidemiology unit
- Local seafarers / sea marshals can be allowed to home quarantine /Immediate care center /designated hospital
- All foreign nationals (apart from diplomatic / resident visa holders) will be sent to an immediate care center managed by private hospitals

Other Measures

- In charge of quarantine hotel /quarantine center/ hotel doctor level 1/staff of the airport should verify the status of the vaccination
- In charge of quarantine hotel /quarantine center/ hotel doctor level 1 should issue a 'discharge document' when discharging travelers after quarantine
- Quarantine period of the traveler will be extended, if they are identified as the immediate close contact of a COVID 19 positive person or if they arriving form a high risk country as decided by MOH
